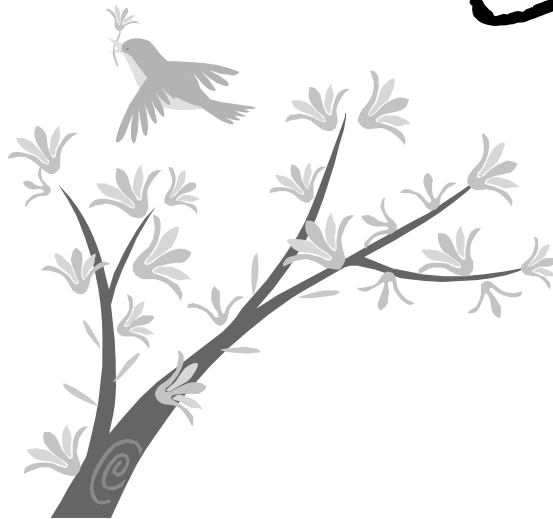

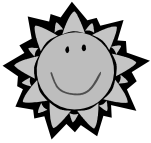
A Certified SHINE Counselor will be here to explain the Medicare components and review the Assistance Programs that can save you hundreds of dollars a year in out of pocket medical expenses.

A Re-evaluation of your current financial situation may qualify you

- * To pay a reduced co-pay amount for prescription drugs
- * To pay a reduced prescription drug coverage premium (or to even receive premium free prescription drug coverage)
- * To receive assistance with paying for your Medicare Part B premium.

The SHINE Counselor will also review the Health Care Reform changes that will affect your Medicare coverage in 2011.

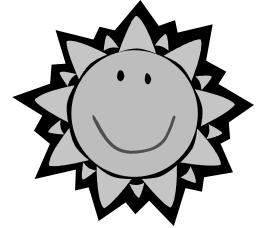

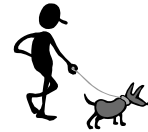

What a fascinating evening we had!

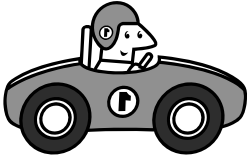
