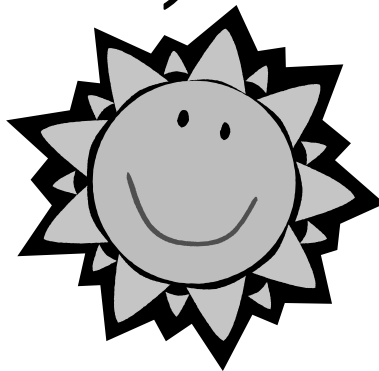

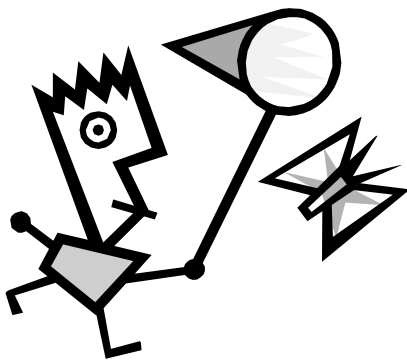

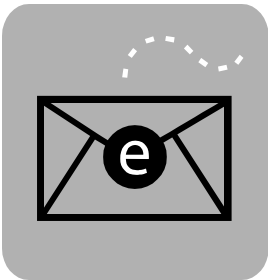
“BIG e-mail Mistake”

The widow's son rushed into the room, found his mother on the floor, and then glanced up and saw the computer screen which read:

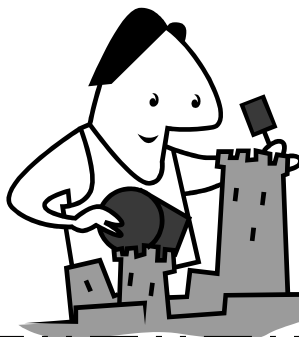
To: My Loving Wife

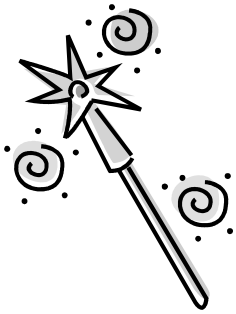

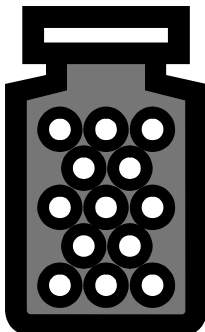
Our very own **Nancy Luedeman** from WV3 thought about a mural for the fencing at the back of the dumpster facing WV 3. What do you think?

Help for Africa

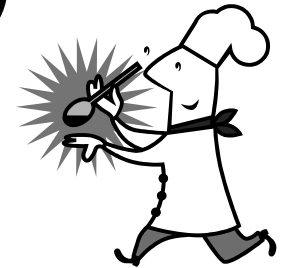
