Hope you all have a Happy and Healthy 2009 – did I hear yard sale next year?



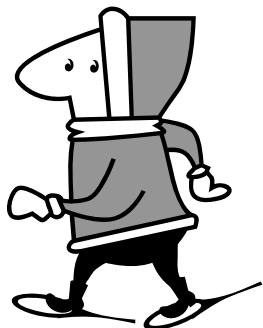
