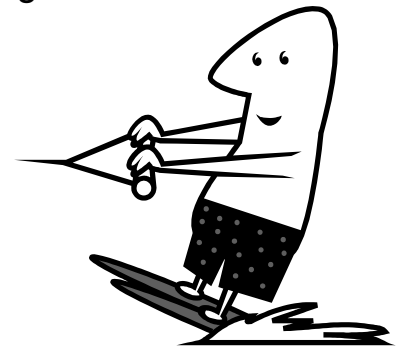

A GRAND IEH PICNIC.

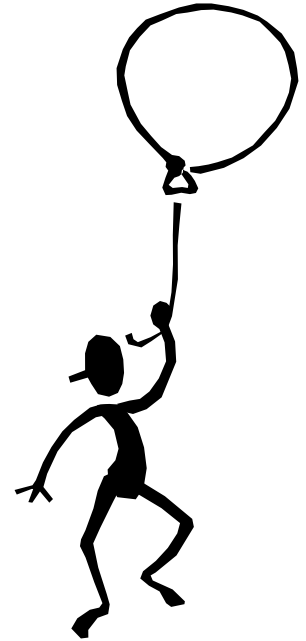
What you will need to bring:

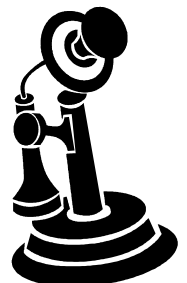

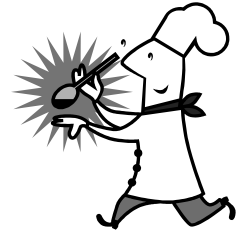
