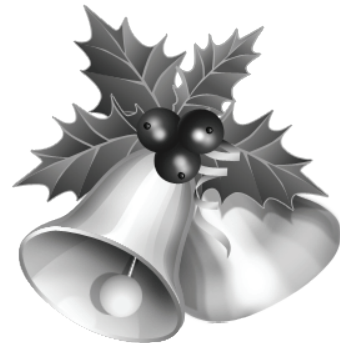

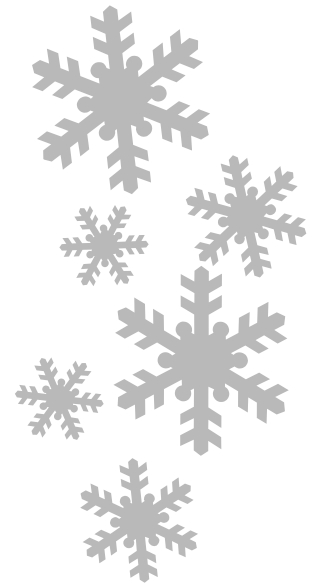

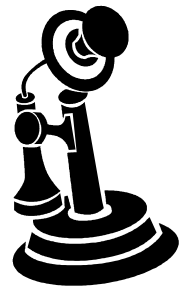
New 2010 VTA Senior Bus Passes are available for \$15. Please call Ann Baird if you need one — 508-693-7009.

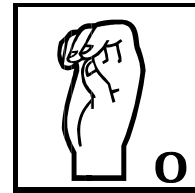
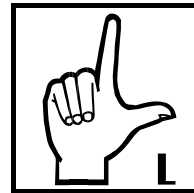
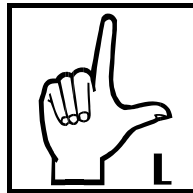
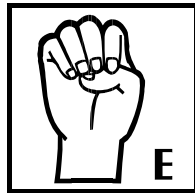
On January 4th we'll be **Reviewing**.

Once you learn the manual Alphabet you'll be able to **Finger-Spell** and communicate with anyone that knows the **Manual Alphabet**.

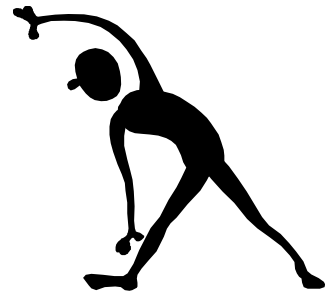
Our hope is to enable residents of IEH (Woodside Village in particular) to become a community where sign language is an easy solution for breaking through communication barriers with friends and family.
